Włącz nagranie i posłuchajcie głoski oraz wyrazów jeszcze raz.

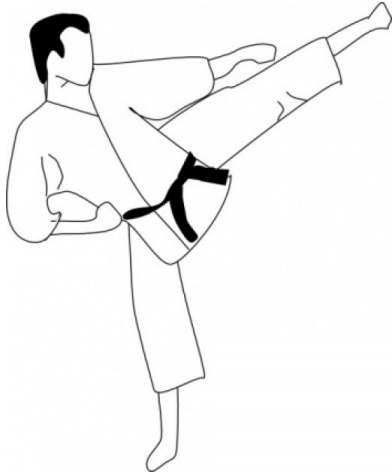
Rozmawianie o obrazkach pomoże dziecku zrozumieć znaczenie słów.

Mamy nadzieję, że z przyjemnością będziecie korzystać z dzieckiem z tych materiałów.

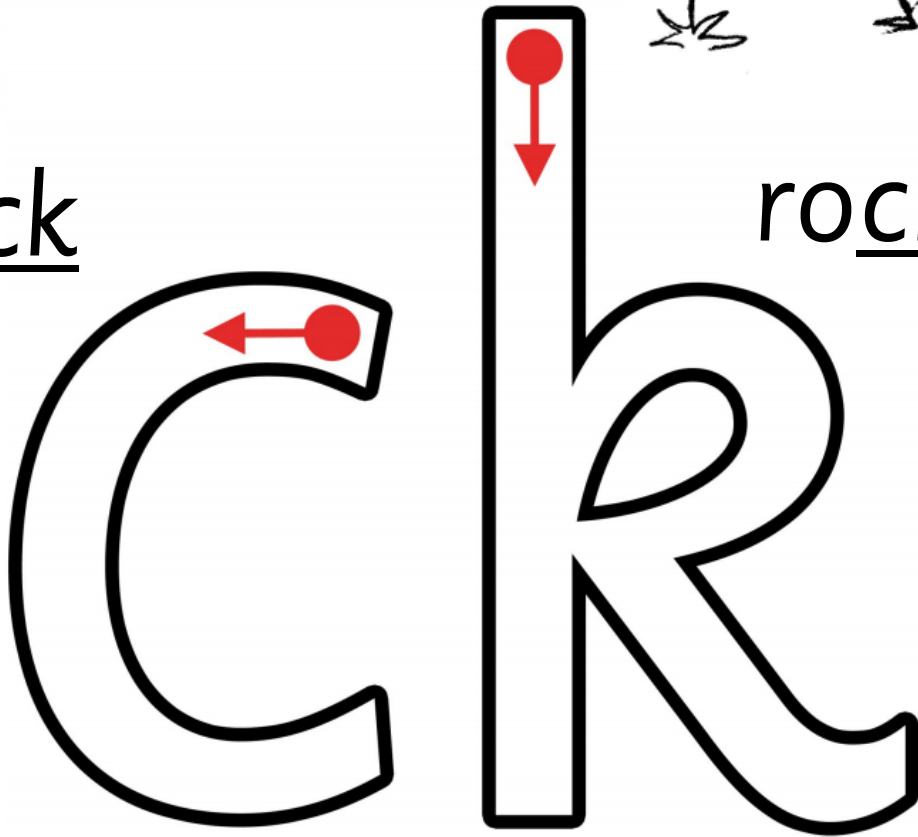
