

Consultation on National Breakfast Club offer

The Scottish Government is developing a National Breakfast Club Offer, with the aim of making a free breakfast club available to all children in primary school, including children attending special schools, by August 2027.

The offer is intended to provide children with access to a nutritious breakfast and a positive, supportive start to the school day, while also giving parents and carers the option of an early drop-off before school.

The programme forms part of wider work to build a system of school age childcare in Scotland. The Scottish Government hopes that breakfast clubs can help reduce the cost of the school day, support parents to work, study or train, and improve outcomes for children, including attendance, wellbeing and readiness to learn. Provision is expected to be delivered flexibly, recognising that the needs of children, families and communities may differ across Scotland.

Whether your family currently uses a breakfast club or not, we are interested in understanding your needs, any barriers you may face in accessing support, and what would be most important to you in a future breakfast club offer. Your insights will help inform the development of the National Breakfast Club Offer and our understanding of the needs and circumstances of families of children attending special schools and children with additional support needs in mainstream settings.
